

Volunteer Job Description

IN-PRISON VOLUNTEER – Sunday Services

Major Objective/s:

- To facilitate access and continued delivery of Protestant Services to the inmate population housed at the Montgomery County Correctional Facility

Responsibilities:

- Establish a friendly, teaching relationship with the inmates.
- Teach by example, the reverence due to God and His sanctuary.
- Provide direct and indirect support to the facilitator

Qualifications:

- Prior experience working with offenders either in prison or at an aftercare facility preferred, but not required.
- Willingness to teach within concepts delineated in Liberty Ministries' Statement of Faith
- Demonstrated passion for this often overlooked mission field.
- Must be willing to commit to consistent service
- Need Reliable Transportation

Training/Preparation:

- Must complete the Liberty Ministries Volunteer Application Package
- Must submit to a Pennsylvania State Police Background investigation (a prior record may not necessarily preclude a candidate from volunteering, but failure to be truthful will).
- On-going support is tailored to each volunteer's specific needs.

Days / Times:

- To be determined by the need of the ministry and personal preference of the volunteer.
